

SUMMARY OF REQUIREMENTS

RESTRICTED PRACTISING CERTIFICATE

Please send in the following, duly completed, to the Secretary, PNG Law Society, P O Box 2004, Port Moresby: -

1. Completed Application for Restricted Practising Certificate.
2. Payment **to the Papua New Guinea Law Society** of **K2174.00 (for a citizen)** or **-K2891.00 (for a non-citizen resident in Papua New Guinea)** for each application.
3. A Statutory Declaration as required by the *Lawyers (Trust Account) Regulation 1990*.
4. Statement in Writing on Oath as to Citizenship or Residence.

UNRESTRICTED PRACTISING CERTIFICATE

(a) Lawyers Resident in Papua New Guinea.

Please send in the following, duly completed, to the Secretary, PNG Law Society, P O Box 2004, Port Moresby:-

1. Application for an Unrestricted Practising Certificate duly completed;
2. Your payment to the Papua New Guinea Law Society, of **K4675.00 (for a citizen)** or **K5663.00 (for a non-citizen resident in Papua New Guinea)** for each application;
3. If not already submitted, a Trust Account Audit Report in accordance with the *Lawyers (Trust Account) Regulation 1990*, or where no monies are received or held for or on behalf of another person, a Statutory Declaration made to that effect.

(b) Non-Citizen Lawyers Resident Overseas

Please send in the following, duly completed, to the Secretary, PNG Law Society, PO Box 2004, Port Moresby, Papua New Guinea: -

1. Application for an Unrestricted Practising Certificate
2. Payment to the Papua New Guinea Law Society of the fee for each application – **K8018.00**
3. Evidence of professional indemnity insurance for a minimum of K500, 000 applicable in PNG.
4. A Statutory Declaration in accordance with the annexed form as required by the *Lawyers (Trust Account) Regulation 1990*.
